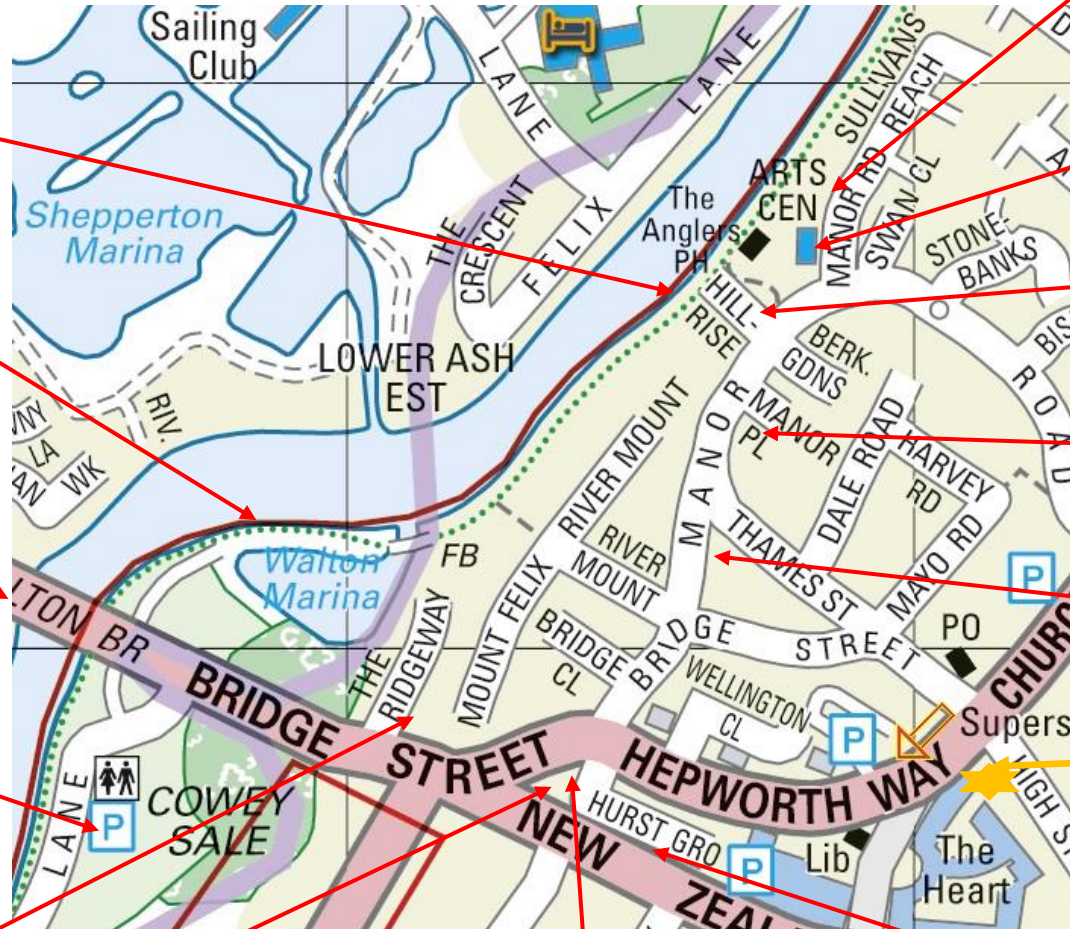




Thames River Route

A 2-mile route covering 13 historic sites in Walton-on-Thames

Continue along Thames Path, past Anglers pub.
After 400 yards, turn right through gate into Riverhouse Park. Exit park to right.



Riverhouse
Composer Sir Arthur Sullivan's home and garden.

Riverhouse Barn
Manorial barn dated 1721, now an arts centre and community café.

Swan Hotel
American composer Jerome Kern married the owner's daughter Eva Leale in 1930's.

Manor House
Grade 1 listed building and plaque.

Thames Cottage—Grade II listed, originally the local ferry company's offices.

START by WoTTA totem outside Carpetright. Proceed past Library along Hepworth Way.

14-16 Hurst Grove
Once home of Cecil Hepworth, a founder of the British film industry.

Cecil Hepworth Playhouse
Site of Hepworth Film Studios, the first in Britain.

Aston Martin Garage
Site of first Aston Martin garage in the country, also rumoured to be where Charlie Chaplin had his dressing room.

Mount Felix Clock Tower
Follow signs to the Clock House. Site of a stately home used as a WW1 hospital for New Zealand soldiers.

Cowey Sale
Reputed site of Caesar's crossing of the Thames in 54BC.

Walton Bridge
6th bridge on the site and the newest across the Thames, opened in 2013.

River Thames
The Thames Path extends 184 miles from source to mouth.

Walton Wharf
17th century river wharf.

Turn right into Manor Road

Turn left into Thames Street

Follow Thames Path past Walton Marina.

Follow Thames Path under Walton Bridge.

Take footpath across viaduct, past blue plaque by WoTTA naming Anzac Way, Take path before bridge down to river.
